

PROPOSITION 8 - SPORTS FACILITIES



Proposition 8 focuses on sports and public facilities improvements across Broken Arrow. Unlike the other propositions, Proposition 8 would be funded through a temporary 0.5% sales tax increase dedicated specifically to public sports facilities improvements. **If approved, this sales tax would be implemented on July 1, 2026, and expire on June 30, 2031, and would be dedicated to only funding the projects in this proposition.**

IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

(Arrowhead, Nienhuis, Challenger sports complexes on back)

Indian Springs Sports Complex

- \$4 Million** ▶ Parking improvements
- \$1 Million** ▶ Common area upgrades - Picnic tables, shade, trees, signage, equipment
- \$3 Million** ▶ Parks Dept. maintenance building
- \$5 Million** ▶ Soccer - Turf conversion four fields
- \$3.3 Million** ▶ Soccer - LED field lighting system retrofit
- \$50,000** ▶ Soccer - Sidewalk connections to various fields
- \$950,000** ▶ Baseball - New restroom near fields 9 & 10
- \$2.6 Million** ▶ Baseball - Turf conversion 16 infields of various size fields
- \$4 Million** ▶ Baseball - Regrade & sod 16 outfields of various size fields
- \$2.35 Million** ▶ Baseball - LED field lighting system retrofit
- \$100,000** ▶ Baseball - Safety netting
- \$600,000** ▶ Adult Softball - Turf conversion 2 infields
- \$480,000** ▶ Adult Softball - Regrade & sod 2 outfields
- \$400,000** ▶ Adult Softball - Concession stand renovations
- \$300,000** ▶ Adult Softball - LED lighting system retrofit

Arrowhead Sports Complex - Girls Softball

Challenger Sports Complex

\$250,000	▶ New playground	\$20,000	▶ Batting cages
\$850,000	▶ Parking lot expansion	\$150,000	▶ Bridge connection between field 1 and fields 2, 3, 4



\$415 Million ▶ If Propositions 1 through 7 are approved by voters, the city's current property tax rate would remain the same, and those taxes would fund improvement projects outlined in each of the first 7 propositions.

\$53 Million ▶ If Proposition 8 is approved by voters, it would include a temporary, 5-year half-penny sales tax increase to pay for improvements at the public sports facilities in Broken Arrow. The temporary increase would begin on July 1, 2026 and end on June 30, 2031.
